Roy gave us some general tips before we got real technical. They were: 1. Read as much as Possible before you start working on a carburator. 2. Working on the carburator is the last thing to do to get your car to run right. 3. If your car is running rough it is not JUST the carburator. 4. For British cars, if it is running rough - adjust the valves !!!! 5. The Zenith gives more Problems than the SU. The Zenith was used because of emmissions standards. 6. The oil in the damper is to keep the carburator from flooding. The type of oil is not critical. However, the best oil was stated to be AUTOMATIC TRANSMISSION FLUID.


